

IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off - Final: CWE + Interview Score

A large number of candidates appeared for the IBPS PO Mains 2015 and only 40,763 candidates qualified for the interview round. As interview round gets completed curiosity regarding final IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off 2015.

In this article we are going to explain you **IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off after CWE and interview round and how IBPS PO Mains 2015 Cut Offs going to help us to calculate IBPS PO Final cut off.** So buck up and read on.

IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off for 2015 for CWE + Interview Scores

Many candidates who appeared for personal interviews are quite curious to know about cut-offs. But before we proceed you should know that these cut offs are based on our analysis of the past year cut offs and it is not guaranteed that the final cut offs will be the same as the cut offs listed below as they have not been declared by the institute of banking personnel selection.

Let's us first look at the **IBPS PO Mains Official Cut off for 2015 (2015)**

Category	Number of marks
General	76
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	76
Schedule Cast (SC)	50
Schedule Tribe (ST)	47.75

For your convenience, **we also bring you the previous year IBPS PO Final cut offs before calculating the same for this year so that you can have a better idea regarding the cut offs:**

IBPS PO Final Cut off 2014

Category	Number of marks
General	82
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	80
Schedule Cast (SC)	70
Schedule Tribe (ST)	56

As we can observe, this year's IBPS PO Mains 2015 cut-offs are relatively less than that of last year's. However, it is likely that the difficulty level and allotment of marks for IBPS interviews remain the same as that of 2014 and 2015.

The final scores will be calculated based on the Mains exam and interview marks in the ratio 80:20 respectively. So it means, for our purpose of IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off, marks obtained in the Mains exam will be calculated out of 80 and marks obtained in the interview will be calculated out of 20.

So,

The final score = [Mains exam marks/ 200 * 80] + [Interview marks/100 * 20]

Due to the decrease in Mains exam cut-offs, the final cut-offs might also decrease this year.

So, before calculating this year's final cutoffs let's go through the **IBPS PO 2014 final cutoffs (out of 80)**.

The final cutoffs for IBPS PO 2014 (Out of 80)

Category	Number of marks
General	49.6
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	45.6
Schedule Cast (SC)	42.2
Schedule Tribe (ST)	36.4

The cutoffs general category candidate in IBPS PO 2014 written exam = 82 marks

The cutoffs general category candidate in IBPS PO 2015 Mains exam = 76 marks

The difference of marks = 6 marks

If we calculate the 'Difference of marks' out of 80, we will get the difference in the final cutoffs of **IBPS PO 2014 & 2015 respectively**

Based on this difference we have calculated the Final IBPS PO Mains Expected Cut Off 2015

Category	Number of marks
General	47.2
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	44
Schedule Cast (SC)	34.2
Schedule Tribe (ST)	33.1

So that's it. This is the expected IBPS PO Final expected Cut off.

Disclaimer: *The above cutoffs are arrived after some estimates and considering the last years and this year's mains cut offs. The final cut off marks maybe similar or completely different. Take these as an approx and not the exact value.*
